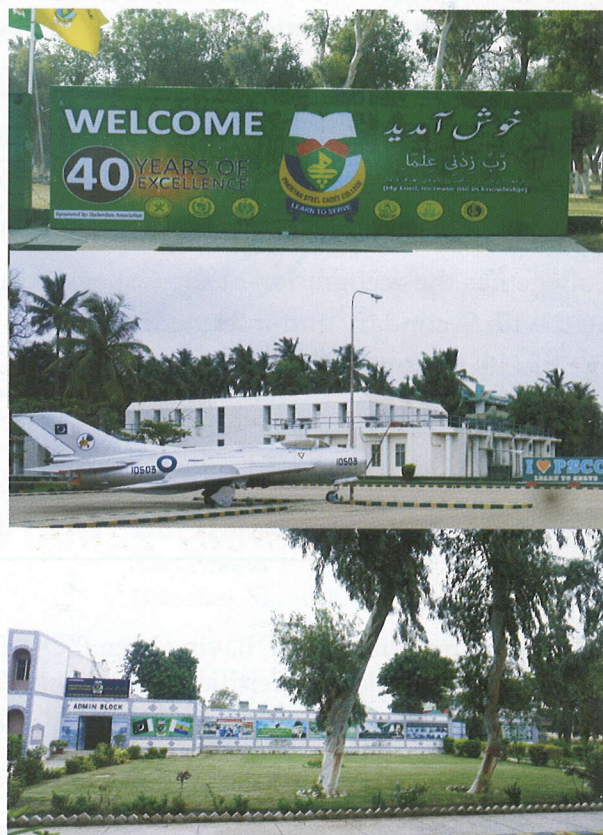


INTRODUCTION

Located at the scenic Steel Town, some 40 kilometers east of the metropolis-Karachi, is Pakistan Steel Cadet College. It was established in 1982, to offer an opportunity to the capable children of the country to receive high quality education and training. The college is a residential institution having a capacity to house 500 cadets. The college administration **makes every possible effort**, to produce young men having capability to enter life with confidence, courage and sense of responsibility.

Academics is the area in which the College distinguishes itself the most. Highly qualified and experienced faculty members spend maximum time with the cadets as mentors. The college combines the cultural and intellectual legacies of the past with a pragmatic concern for meeting the challenges of the present and the future. The major objective is to provide individuals with the educational foundation necessary to meet the demands of contemporary society. The institution's aim is to prepare individuals for life and work by teaching and counseling in a variety of skills and ways that can be applied in almost all occupational settings. It helps enable the individual to pursue defined career goals within the desired contexts. This system, combined with purposely kept small classes, provides students with personalized attention and close interaction and encourages both academic growth and personal development.

CALENDAR AND SYSTEM OF EXAMINATION

Terms

There are two terms in each academic year. Leave / Holidays will be granted as per College Calendar.

Calendar

College calendar showing the schedule of activities and holidays is sent to the parents/guardians at the beginning of each term.

System of Examination

Fortnightly/Monthly tests, Terminal, Preliminary and Annual Examinations are held to assess the progress of each student.

Admission

a-Admission to Class - VIII

Students are admitted to Class-VIII purely on merit, on the basis of their performance in the admission test and interview.

b-Eligibility

Candidates for admission to class VIII must have passed (or appeared or be appearing) class VII examination, from a recognized school, at the time of admission to the Cadet College.

c-Procedure for Admission in Class VIII

Admission is open to candidates from all over Pakistan and abroad. The candidates are required to take a written test of Class VII standard in English, Urdu, Islamiyat, Maths, General Science and General Knowledge. This is followed by an Interview and Medical Examination. Selected candidates are admitted strictly on merit to fill the number of seats available each year.

- Applications for admission are usually advertised in leading Daily Newspapers of the country, during the months of October and November each year.
- Written tests are usually held during December/January and are followed by interviews.
- Tests/ Interviews are held at Karachi, Multan, Lahore, Islamabad & Faisalabad
- If good no. of applications are received from Quetta, Sukkur & Peshawar then the Entry test will be held in these cities as well.
- Admissions are made strictly on merit. Merely passing the test does not entitle a candidate to admission.
- Full College fee is to be paid at the beginning of each academic year.
- The amount of fee can be revised by the Board of Governors of the College at any time without notice.
- The decision of the Admission Committee will be the final.

d- Admission Form

Admission form is given at the end of this prospectus. Please, detach and send the form duly filled, in the envelope provided for this purpose, to the Principal, by the due date, as advertised.

e- Age Limit

The age bracket for admission to class VIII is from 12 to 14 years. The date is reckoned from 01 April of the year of admission.

f- Migration

Migration cases shall be entertained from Cadet College to Cadet College on merit and as per the availability of seats.

g- Admission to Class-XI

The promotion or continuance in Class-XI is not an automatic process. The class-X cadets, who wish to continue in the College, must have an excellent record in all fields to their credit. After declaration of the results of SSC part-II (Class-X) Examination, a cadet will not be allowed to continue in Class-XI if he fails to achieve at least grade "A".

- Admission in Class-XI will purely be on merit.
- Remaining seats will be filled on Self Finance Basis.

h- Continuation to Class-XII

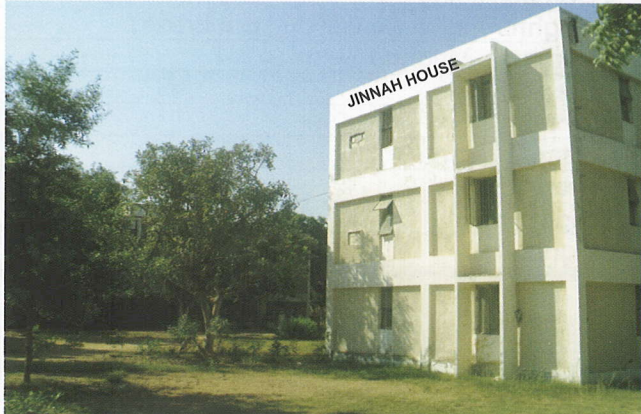
On the declaration of HSC-I Board results, a cadet may not be allowed to continue in class XII, If he fails in any subject of Class-XI.

HOSTELS

Hostel life plays an important role in moulding the character of a student in a residential institution. It inculcates in the cadets the habit of regularity in their activities, both at work and in leisure. Another important feature of hostel life is that it develops life-long comradeship among the students.

There are five Houses, each accommodating upto 100 students. The Houses are named after great Muslim leaders, generals and scholars. Each House has all the facilities for comfortable living, including Newspapers, Magazines & House Library.

Each House is supervised by a House Master who is assisted by two to four House Officers. The House Master acts like a parent to the cadets and helps them to solve all their educational, social and personal problems. Senior Cadets are given various appointments in the Houses on merit, so as to develop qualities of leadership in them. The House Master has to look after and ensure overall upbringing, discipline and character building of the cadets.



DAILY ROUTINE

DISCIPLINE

a-General

Cadets are taught to instill discipline in all their activities. This goes a long way towards moulding their character and personality

b-Chain of Command

Discipline is maintained by the College Adjutant through a chain of command of the cadets' appointments. College Senior Under Officer is the highest appointment for the cadets. He is assisted in the performance of his duties by a College Junior Under Officer, College Sergeant Major, College Sports Secretary, Secretary Literary Society, Senior/ Junior under Officers of each House.

c-Punishment for Late Arrival after Leave/Vacation

The following punishments will be awarded to a cadet, if he comes late, or absents himself on the expiry of leave or vacation:

- i. Late arrival by over one hour : a fine of Rs. 500 /-
- ii. Absence for one day : a fine of Rs. 1000/- per day upto a maximum of six days. (Extra drill, etc., may also be awarded in addition to the fine).
- iii. The name of cadet will be struck off the College after the six days' unauthorized absence, without any further notice.

Note : The name of the cadet will be struck off the College after six days of absence. In case of re-joining the admission fee and other expenditures as per the College rules will be charged.

Rules for Expulsion

A cadet will be expelled from the College if :

- i. His academic progress, conduct or behaviour is consistently found unsatisfactory.
- ii. Caught in stealing activities.
- iii. Found guilty of moral turpitude.
- iv. Takes part in political activities or tries to promote sectarianism in the College.
- v. If declared medically unfit at any stage during his training in the College
- vi. Remains absent from the College, without permission, continuously for one week or more.
- vii. Bunks from the College.
- viii. If caught cheating in an examination.
- ix. Gambles.
- x. Uses intoxicants or smokes.
- xi. Displays insolent behaviour towards any member of the College Staff.
- xii. Willfully damages the College property.
- xiii. Keeps unauthorized drugs.
- xiv. Brings mobile/cell phone, other electronic devices or any musical instrument to the College.
- xv. Keeps fire arms, knives or weapon of any sort.
- xvi. Found guilty of gross violation of College rules.
- xvii. Fails to clear the College dues within the scheduled period.
- xviii. Found breaking the bounds.
- xix. Harassing juniors, grave misconduct outside the College campus or any other offence which in the opinion of the discipline committee requires expulsion from the College.

Decision taken by the discipline committee in disciplinary cases is final and shall not be challenged in any court of law.

Punishable Offences

Following offences are punishable with strict disciplinary actions i.e. suspension, parents call, warning letter, fine up to Rs. 5000/- , and head shave etc:-

- i. Caught with any electronic devices i.e. mobile phone, power bank, MP3 player, head phones etc.
- ii. Caught with low category intoxicants i.e. cigarettes, naswar etc.
- iii. Bunk case.
- iv. Failing and cheating in exams.
- v. Involved in mutiny, fighting and grouping etc.
- vi. Habitual defaulter of routine activities.
- vii. Habitual late comer from leave or weekends.
- viii. Involved in damaging college property whose actual cost will be borne by the defaulter.
- ix. Violation of any serious discipline.

Accident / Mishap

The College will adopt all possible measures for the safety of the cadets during their stay in the College Campus. However, the College shall not be responsible for any kind of accident/mishaps causing any physical harm or injury

Special Instructions

For the wedding ceremony of real brother and real sister of a cadet, parents are requested to schedule the wedding ceremony in accordance with the rules in the light of College Calendar's off days. There will be no leave for wedding ceremony of any relative except real brother or real sister during a session.

Any disinformation from the parents on social media regarding the **institution**, teaching staff/ non teaching staff or administration of Pakistan Steel **Cadet College**, **will result** in their **son/ward's** termination from the college, with or without warning depending upon the gravity of the blame.

Calendar Events

A calendar of events showing all the details of vacations/holidays, in addition to the schedule of curricular and co-curricular events organized throughout the year is published and issued to all the cadets and their parents/guardians at the beginning of each session. All efforts are made to observe Holidays/Vacations, Events, Exams, PTM, Competitions indicated in the College Calendar of year.

FACILITIES

Library

The College has a well stocked library. Cadets visit the library during the library periods as well as during the leisure time. Books are available on all important subjects. A qualified librarian (MLIS) manages the library.

Canteen / Cafeteria

There is a canteen cum cafeteria for the cadets where they can buy almost anything they are likely to need while living in the Hostels. They can also have cold drinks/tea/snacks when they are free in the afternoon or on holidays and satisfy their hunger with the best available quality food.

Laboratories

Information Technology is the most important source of manipulating information and gathering latest knowledge in a modern way. Keeping in view the importance of IT, the College has a well equipped Computer Science Lab with latest Computing Equipment (Core i5 8th generation) including LCD Multimedia Projector and a number of Printers. All the computers of Computer Lab and College are interconnected with each other through a LAN network where Internet is accessible all the time.

College Mess

All cadets have their meals in a fully air- conditioned, properly furnished and efficiently managed Mess. **Meals include: Breakfast, Mid-morning snacks, Lunch, Evening Tea, Dinner & Brunch on Sunday & Holidays.** The menu varies from day to day, providing balanced food to meet the needs of growing young cadets

PSCC Horse Riding Club

Pakistan Steel Cadet College has established its Horse Riding Club facility which is a compulsory activity for all cadets. Horses were purchased from Mona (Army Horse Depot) and local market of Interior Sindh. Furthermore, for the maximum facilitation of cadets' extension of PSSC riding club is in progress.

Medical Facilities

The college has a dispensary of its own, staffed by an M.B.B.S. doctor and full time dispensers. However, serious cases are referred to Pakistan Steel Hospital.

Free Treatment

Outdoor treatment (including routine medicines) and first aid is provided by the College free of Cost.

Treatment On Payment

Charges on account of Indoor treatment and consultation with specialists will have to be borne by the Parents. The expenditure will be recovered from the security deposit which shall then be reimbursed by the Parents.

Security Cameras

Security cameras have been installed throughout the College to ensure the safety and security of the cadets.

D - Admission Fee

E - Self Finance Scheme

Forty (40) seats are allocated for Self Finance Scheme. A candidate who fails to get a seat on merit, may be offered a seat against self-finance scheme, if he clears all the stages of selection procedure. Apart from paying the normal fee, such a candidate shall be required to pay additional amount of Rs. 350,000 (Rupees Three Hundred Fifty Thousands only) once for the admission under this Scheme. The additional amount will be non-refundable in case the candidate stays in College over a month. In case the candidate stays less than or equal to a month, only 50% of the said amount will be deducted and rest of the amount will be returned.

Note

- In case of withdrawal of any cadet during academic term, admission and tuition fee will not be refunded & boarding / lodging will be deducted on the basis of a cadet's stay at College.
- In case of withdrawal of any cadet before the joining, admission fee will not be refunded.
- 5% Annual fee will be enhanced every academic session.

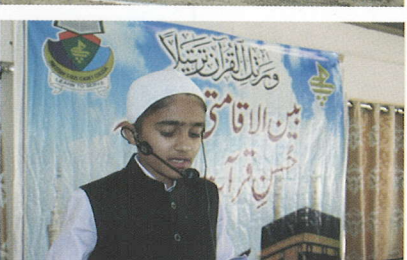

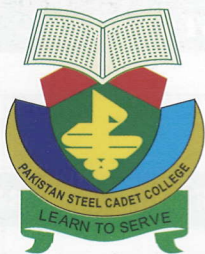
